Precise Words and Specific Details

Precise words and specific details help the reader understand an explanation. As you learned in Unit 1, Lesson 2, being precise and specific helps you create word pictures so the reader can "see" what you mean.

EXAMPLE Read the two explanations for grilling fish. The second one has precise words and specific details; the first one does not.

- Here's a way to cook fish on a grill. First, buy a plank of wood at the store. Clean the plank. Then soak it to prevent it from burning. Next, preheat the coals in your grill. Put the fish on the plank and some herbs on the fish. When the coals are hot, place the plank on the grill with the coals around the edges. Cook for 15 to 20 minutes.
- Here's a healthy, fat-free way of cooking fish that you can use on your barbecue—grilling fish on a wood plank. First, buy a cedar or fir plank at a lumberyard or home supply store. The plank should be cut to 1" by 8" by 18". Second, rinse the plank with water to clean it. Then soak the plank in water for one hour to prevent it from burning on the grill. Next, preheat the coals in your grill. Place the fish on the plank and sprinkle the top of it with fresh herbs. When the coals are hot, place the plank on the grill so that the fish is in the center with the coals around the edges. Cook over a medium fire for 15 to 20 minutes or until the fish is cooked throughout. Then enjoy!

Notice how the precise words (cedar or fir, lumberyard or home supply store, sprinkle) and specific details (1" by 8" by 18", for one hour, medium fire) in the second explanation help you understand much better what to do.
